About the Authentication Module

The Forescout Authentication Module provides network connectivity, visibility, and control through the following plugins:

- [RADIUS Plugin 4.5](#)
- [User Directory Plugin 6.5](#)

The Authentication Module is a Forescout Base Module. Base Modules are delivered with each Forescout release.

Module Requirements

Forescout version 8.2.

Components described in this document may have additional requirements and dependencies.

Install the Module

This module is automatically installed when you upgrade to Forescout version 8.2 or perform a Forescout version 8.2 clean installation. New module releases may become available between Forescout releases.

Module and Component Rollback

The following rollback/upgrade activities are not supported:

- Rolling back a base module (or one of its components) to a version released prior to Forescout 8.2.
- Upgrading to a base module version (or one of its components) released with 8.2 when running a version of the Forescout platform lower than 8.2.

If you upgrade to a newer module or component version that becomes available after this release, you may be able to roll it back. When rollback is supported, the Rollback button is enabled in the Console.

Modules/components on Appliances connected to the Enterprise Manager are rolled back to the selected version. Modules/components on Appliances that are not connected to the Enterprise Manager during the rollback are rolled back when the Enterprise Manager next reconnects to the Appliances.

To roll back the module or component:

1. Select **Options** from the Console **Tools** menu.
2. Navigate to the **Modules** folder.
3. In the Modules pane, select the module or component to be rolled back.

4. Select **Rollback**. A dialog box opens listing the versions to which you can roll back.
5. Select a version and select **OK**. A dialog box opens showing you the rollback progress.

RADIUS Plugin 4.5

The RADIUS Plugin broadens the scope of standard 802.1X authentication technology to include device profiling, endpoint compliance and access and remediation enforcement.

The plugin ensures seamless, comprehensive 802.1X **pre-connect** security and **post-connect** control for both wired and wireless devices and both corporate and guest users.

The RADIUS Plugin enables the Forescout platform to authenticate 802.1X switch/wireless connections to the network. The plugin is compatible with the IEEE 802.1X specification and the RADIUS authentication protocol.

The plugin enables the Forescout platform to provide authentication and authorization instructions to NAS devices, to integrate with user directory servers and to employ powerful Forescout 802.1X policies to detect, authenticate, and control network endpoints and associated user activity.

The plugin supports authentication, authorization, and accounting, enabling the Forescout platform to:

- Discover and monitor each 802.1X authenticating device's MAC address, IP address, and other properties.
- Monitor the real-time network connectivity status of 802.1X authenticating devices.
- Automate endpoint control based on device profile and compliance.

User Directory Plugin 6.5

The User Directory Plugin resolves endpoint user details and defines the authentication and directory servers used for endpoint authentication. A real-time display of network information at multiple levels, including user directory information, is available from the Console.

The plugin also enables a variety of other features for handling network guests and the sponsors who approve guest access to the network. These features are described in the *Guest Management Portal How-to Guides* for sponsors and Forescout operators, and in the *Forescout Administration Guide*.
