ARF Reports Module, version 1.03

Requirements

The Module requires the following CounterACT releases and other CounterACT components:

- CounterACT 8.0
- Core Extensions Module version 1.0 with the Reports Plugin running.
- If you want the ARF Reports Module to provide CPE information about Windows endpoints, install Windows Applications version 2.1.4.
- If you want ARF Reports Module to provide CPE information about Macintosh and Linux endpoints, you must have Endpoint Module version 1.0 with the following components running:
 - Linux Plugin, if there are Linux endpoints in your environment
 - OS X Plugin, if there are macOS/OS X endpoints in your environment

How to Install

To install the module:

1. Navigate to one of the following ForeScout download portals, depending on the licensing mode your deployment is using:
 - [Product Updates Portal](#) - **Per-Appliance Licensing Mode**
 - [Customer Portal, Downloads Page](#) - **Centralized Licensing Mode**To find out which licensing mode your deployment is working with, see [Identifying Your Licensing Mode in the Console](#).
2. Download the module **.fpi** file.
3. Save the file to the machine where the CounterACT Console is installed.
4. Log into the CounterACT Console and select **Options** from the **Tools** menu.
5. Select **Modules**. The Modules pane opens.
6. Select **Install**. The Open dialog box opens.
7. Browse to and select the saved module **.fpi** file.
8. Select **Install**. The Installation screen opens.


9. Select **I agree to the License Agreement** to confirm that you have read and agree to the terms of the License Agreement, and select **Install**. The installation will not proceed if you do not agree to the license agreement.
 - 📄 *The installation will begin immediately after selecting Install, and cannot be interrupted or canceled.*
 - 📄 *In modules that contain more than one component, the installation proceeds automatically one component at a time.*

10. When the installation completes, select **Close** to close the window. The installed module is displayed in the Modules pane.
 - 📄 *Some components are not automatically started following installation.*

Identifying Your Licensing Mode in the Console

If your Enterprise Manager has a *ForeScout CounterACT See* license listed in the Console, your deployment is operating in Centralized Licensing Mode. If not, your deployment is operating in Per-Appliance Licensing Mode.

Select **Options > Licenses** to see whether you have a *ForeScout CounterACT See* license listed in the table.
