About the Hybrid Cloud Module

The Forescout Hybrid Cloud Module provides visibility and control functions across physical and virtual devices that are on-premises and off-premises through the following components:

- [AWS Plugin 2.2](#)
- [Azure Plugin 1.1](#)
- [VMware NSX Plugin 1.3](#)
- [VMware vSphere Plugin 2.5](#)

The Hybrid Cloud Module is a Forescout Base Module. Base Modules are delivered with each Forescout release.

Module Requirements

Forescout version 8.2.

Components described in this document may have additional requirements and dependencies.

Install the Module

This module is automatically installed when you upgrade to Forescout version 8.2 or perform a Forescout version 8.2 clean installation. New module releases may become available between Forescout releases.

Module Component Rollback

The following rollback/upgrade activities are not supported:

- Rolling back a base module (or one of its components) to a version released prior to Forescout 8.2.
- Upgrading to a base module version (or one of its components) released with 8.2 when running a version of the Forescout platform lower than 8.2.

If you upgrade to a newer module or component version that becomes available after this release, you may be able to roll it back. When rollback is supported, the Rollback button is enabled in the Console.

Modules/components on Appliances connected to the Enterprise Manager are rolled back to the selected version. Modules/components on Appliances that are not connected to the Enterprise Manager during the rollback are rolled back when the Enterprise Manager next reconnects to the Appliances.

To roll back the module or component:

1. Select **Options** from the Console **Tools** menu.
2. Navigate to the **Modules** folder.

3. In the Modules pane, select the module or component to be rolled back.
4. Select **Rollback**. A dialog box opens listing the versions to which you can roll back.
5. Select a version and select **OK**. A dialog box opens showing you the rollback progress.

AWS Plugin 2.2

The AWS Plugin connects to the Amazon® Web Services (AWS) public cloud environment to retrieve information on Elastic Compute Cloud (EC2) instances and other AWS entities such as Identity and Access Management (IAM) users, Virtual Private Clouds (VPCs), and Amazon Simple Storage Service (S3). The EC2 instances, IAM users, and VPCs follow rules similar to those for other endpoints discovered by the Forescout platform where policies and actions can be defined on those entities. The Forescout platform's integration with AWS brings the detailed visibility, control, and compliance capabilities of the Forescout platform to EC2 instances and the associated AWS cloud configurations.

The AWS Plugin lets you:

- View endpoints, IAM users, and VPCs in Amazon's public cloud
- Create and apply Forescout policies across the AWS entities
- Maintain the security and compliance of cloud instances, IAM users, S3s, and VPCs
- Apply security groups to instances, enforce password policies, and perform a range of other policy actions

Azure Plugin 1.1

The Azure Plugin connects to the Microsoft® Azure public cloud environment to retrieve information on Virtual Machine (VM) instances and other Azure entities, such as Virtual Networks (VNets). The VM instances and VNets follow rules similar to those of other endpoints discovered by the Forescout platform, where policies and actions can be defined on those entities. The integration of the Forescout platform with Azure brings the detailed visibility, control, and compliance capabilities of the Forescout platform to Azure VM instances and the associated Azure cloud configurations.

The Azure Plugin lets you:

- See VM instances and VNets in Microsoft Azure's public cloud
- Create and apply Forescout policies across Azure entities
- Maintain the security and compliance of Azure VM instances and VNets
- Start and stop a VM instance, enable delete protection on a VM instance, and a range of other policy actions

VMware NSX Plugin 1.3

The VMware NSX Plugin provides integration with the VMware NSX Network Virtualization and Security Platform. VMware NSX is an integral part of VMware's Software Defined Data Center (SDDC) deployment that delivers micro-segmentation and granular security to the individual workload, thus enabling a more secure data center.

This integration provides users control functionality for virtual endpoints that are part of the data center managed by VMware vCenter® and VMware NSX. Using the capabilities offered by this integration, you can apply micro-segmentation on virtual machines (VM) based on user-defined security policies. For example,

- Forescout policies can be written based on OS patch status and, if needed, vulnerable VMs can be segmented by applying a security group that disallows all communication to and from that virtual endpoint.

VMware vSphere Plugin 2.5

Forescout integration with VMware vSphere brings the detailed visibility, control, and compliance capabilities of the Forescout platform to virtualized data center environments. Flexible policy capabilities over campus endpoints are now extended to VMware ESXi™ hosts and virtual machines (VM) in the data center. This includes:

- Visibility into ESXi™ hosts and associated guest VMs with granular detail into various ESXi™ and guest operating system properties.
- Additional inspection of virtual servers through the use of agentless remote inspection or agent-based Secure Connector.
- Control policies over virtual machine state and network access similar to those applied to campus endpoints.
