Upgrade Considerations

ForeScout Certificates

On November 22, 2019, ForeScout Certificates used by the Windows Applications Module were renewed and are now valid until December 2022. Certain certificate fields have been updated or otherwise changed.

- *If you have certificate related access restrictions, you might need to update your whitelists.*

Windows Versions

Support was added for several Windows operating systems flavors in Windows Applications 19.0.11 (and subsequent releases). As a result, the names of some of the other Windows operating system flavors in the **Windows Version** property pane are changed and their checkboxes in the pane might be automatically and undesirably cleared during the upgrade.

This could impact policies that already use the **Windows Version** property. Therefore, when you upgrade from Windows Applications versions released prior to Windows Applications 19.0.11, make sure to verify that the **Windows Version** property is still configured correctly.

- Windows 10
- Windows 2012
- Windows server 2016

- Windows server 2019

Install the Module

This section describes how to install the module.

To install the module:

1. Navigate to one of the following ForeScout download portals, depending on the licensing mode your deployment is using:
 - [Product Updates Portal](#) - **Per-Appliance Licensing Mode**
 - [Customer Portal, Downloads Page](#) - **Flexx Licensing Mode**

To identify your licensing mode, select **Help > About ForeScout** from the Console.

2. Download the module `.fpi` file.
3. Save the file to the machine where the Console is installed.
4. Log into the Console and select **Options** from the **Tools** menu.
5. Select **Modules**. The Modules pane opens.
6. Select **Install**. The Open dialog box opens.
7. Browse to and select the saved module `.fpi` file.
8. Select **Install**. The Installation screen opens.
9. Select **I agree to the License Agreement** to confirm that you have read and agree to the terms of the License Agreement and select **Install**. The installation cannot proceed unless you agree to the license agreement.
 - 📖 *The installation begins immediately after selecting Install and cannot be interrupted or canceled.*
 - 📖 *In modules that contain more than one component, the installation proceeds automatically one component at a time.*
10. When the installation completes, select **Close** to close the window. The installed module is displayed in the Modules pane.
 - 📖 *Some components are not automatically started following installation.*
